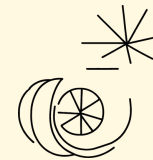
Legend is the golden thread that

The Giant of Garda is considered the guardian of the waters and secrets of the lake.

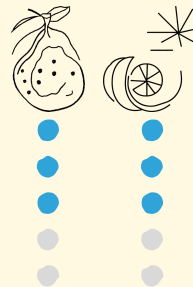
It safeguard Lake Garda and its creatures maintaining the natural balance.

It is said that the mountains close to the lake are nothing but the resting Giant.

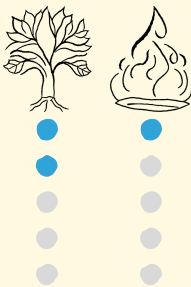

Two young people, in love but from rival families, wish for get married in secret.

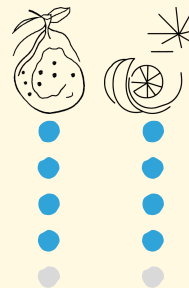
Their families preempted them by destroying the church and threw its bell into depths of the Benaco.

It is said that lovers who approach the lake can still hear a chime, in memory of the love that never was.

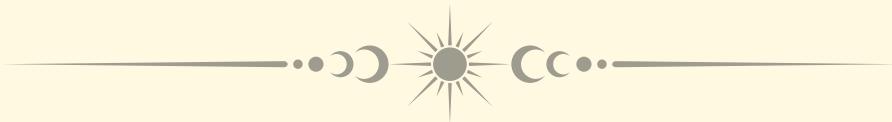
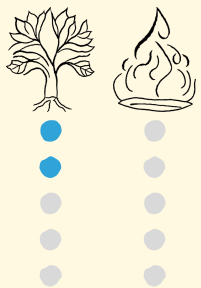

prehistoric being,

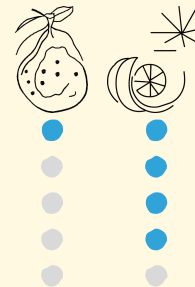
Known as

Sirene and in Gargnano.

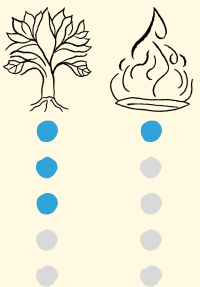

It is said that a merchant was crossing the waters of the lake when he was surprised by a storm.

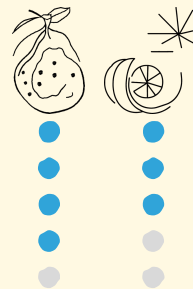
A very precious diamond was lost together with his boat.

Many searched the diamond, but it was destined to belong to the lake's waters for eternity.

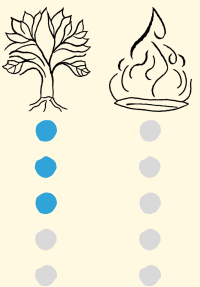


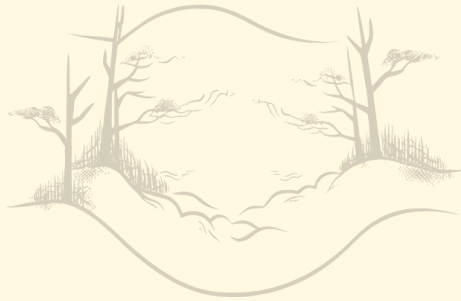

When Lake Garda was still inhabited by deities and mystical creatures, a thick fog enveloped its waters every night.

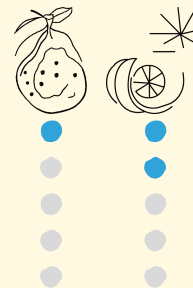
This Mist was considered a veil between the world of men and that of spirits,

A thin border that separated reality from the dimension of magic.

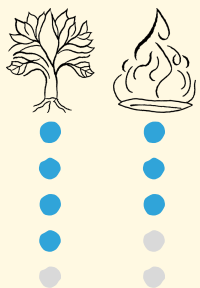

In the woods of San Zeno, in the town of Lumini (little lights),

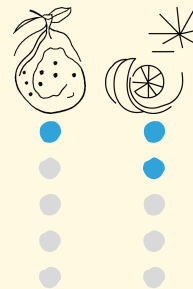
a popular custom was to light bonfires which had the task of protecting citizens from animals and magical creatures.

These fires seen from afar gave the impression that the village was inhabited by many small spirits.

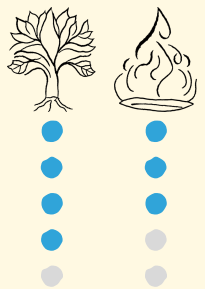

On a hot summer night, some fishermen were lost in a sudden storm.

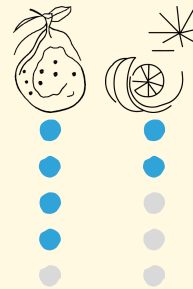
They were at the point of exhaustion when Mermaids appeared.

They offered the sailors a drink that gave them strength and allowed them to return safely.

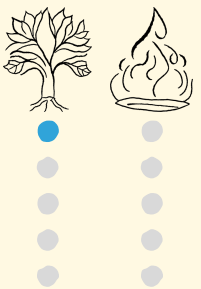
